



LEWIS COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL 2020 INDOOR/OUTDOOR SPECTATOR GUIDELINES



Lewis County High School has worked closely with the KHSAA and our local health department to ensure safety for both athletes and spectators during our school hosted athletic events. To help us be as safe as possible and to help ensure our student athletes continue to compete this season please read and follow the guidelines listed below.

DO



Masks must be worn at all times for all spectators and social distancing is mandatory except with family/car units (who you came with).



Family/car units are expected to sit together and remain together in their group during the event.



Family/car units are expected to remain together except when visiting the restroom or concessions (if available). If a line forms at either destination, social distancing is expected while waiting in line.



All spectators will have their temperature checked at the gate and must answer standard screening questions before entry is permitted. (A temperature above 100.4 will not be permitted to attend)



At the conclusion of the event, all spectators must leave the premises immediately except participants' families. Maintain social distancing as you exit the premises and/or wait on your participant.



(FOOTBALL ONLY) While entering and exiting the stadium seating please follow arrows as aisles are labeled enter or exit by arrows.



(FOOTBALL ONLY) Bring Your Own Chair seating around scoreboard corners of the track: Family/car units must maintain social distancing from each other. Once you are seated remain seated (do not stand during event and/or move seating positions once event has started).

DO NOT



There will be no tailgating before contests



Standing in general areas unless going to or returning from restrooms and/or concessions.



All children must remain seated with family or car unit during event.

Any spectator that does not comply with these regulations will be asked to leave immediately. If all spectators do not adhere to these regulations the event will be stopped.

*These guidelines are subject to change at any time depending on current conditions and advice from local and state health department officials
