Parents/Guardians of Lewis County Student-Athletes:

The Lewis County Athletic Department is excited to announce that fall sports will be taking place in Lewis County! After much work by the KHSAA, local health department, and Lewis County administrators, we have agreed upon the following guidelines, which we believe will promote student safety while participating in sports. In order for this to work, we will need cooperation from coaches, student-athletes, administrators, and parents/guardians.

As much as we appreciate the fan support that Lewis County always has to offer, for the time being, we have to alter our guidelines for participation in order to keep our kids safer. This season we will operate on a mandated, limited fan capacity. This means that we will be offering <u>four</u> tickets per Lewis County coach, player, cheerleader, and band member; as well as two tickets per coach and player for the visiting teams. Coaches will be responsible for gathering information from each student attendee. This information will include name, address, and phone number for contact tracing information related to COVID 19 (mandated by KHSAA). Temperatures will be taken and recorded during admission for all attendees of each sporting event. (No one with a temperature above 100.4 degrees will be admitted)

For those that will be unable to attend, Lewis County Schools will also be offering a new, online service to view most of our events this fall and throughout the year. This service is called Boxcast; anyone can subscribe for a full season, or game by game. More details on this will be available as soon as we finalize pricing our events.

Road games and travel will look different this year as well. Lewis County Schools will continue to provide transportation for all student-athletes. However, this year there will be an option for parents/guardians to transport their children to and from road events as long as the appropriate paperwork is submitted. Please be advised, there will be limited admission for our fans when traveling to other schools. Coaches should have more information on this matter and can pass it along to players, parents, etc.

We are aware this is an inconvenience and disappointment to many. Please remember that these are the steps that we need to take in order to let our student-athletes play and perform in the midst of a global pandemic. As always, your cooperation and support of our schools and programs is tremendously appreciated!
